I can get prepared by grabbing my book bag.

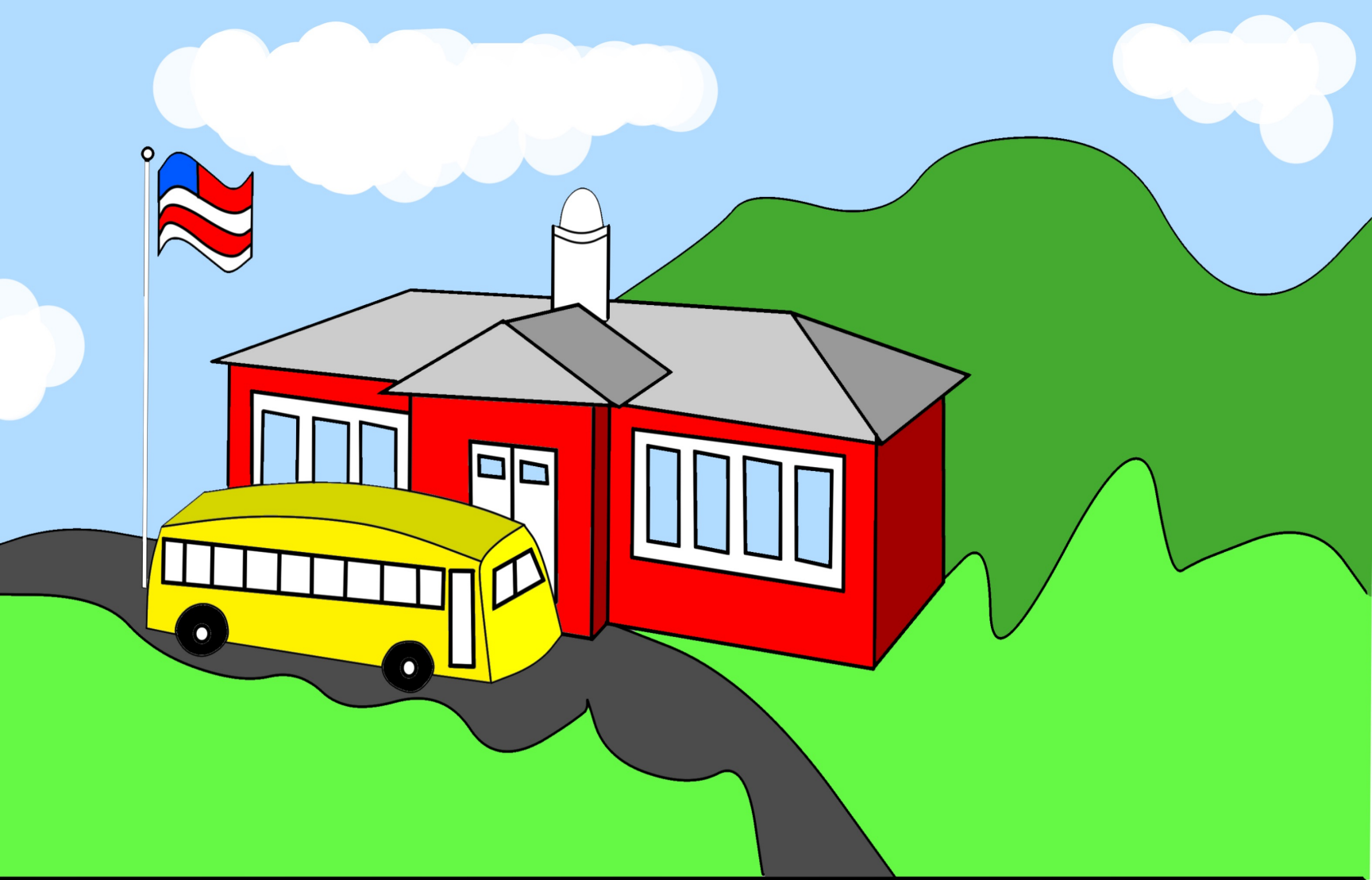

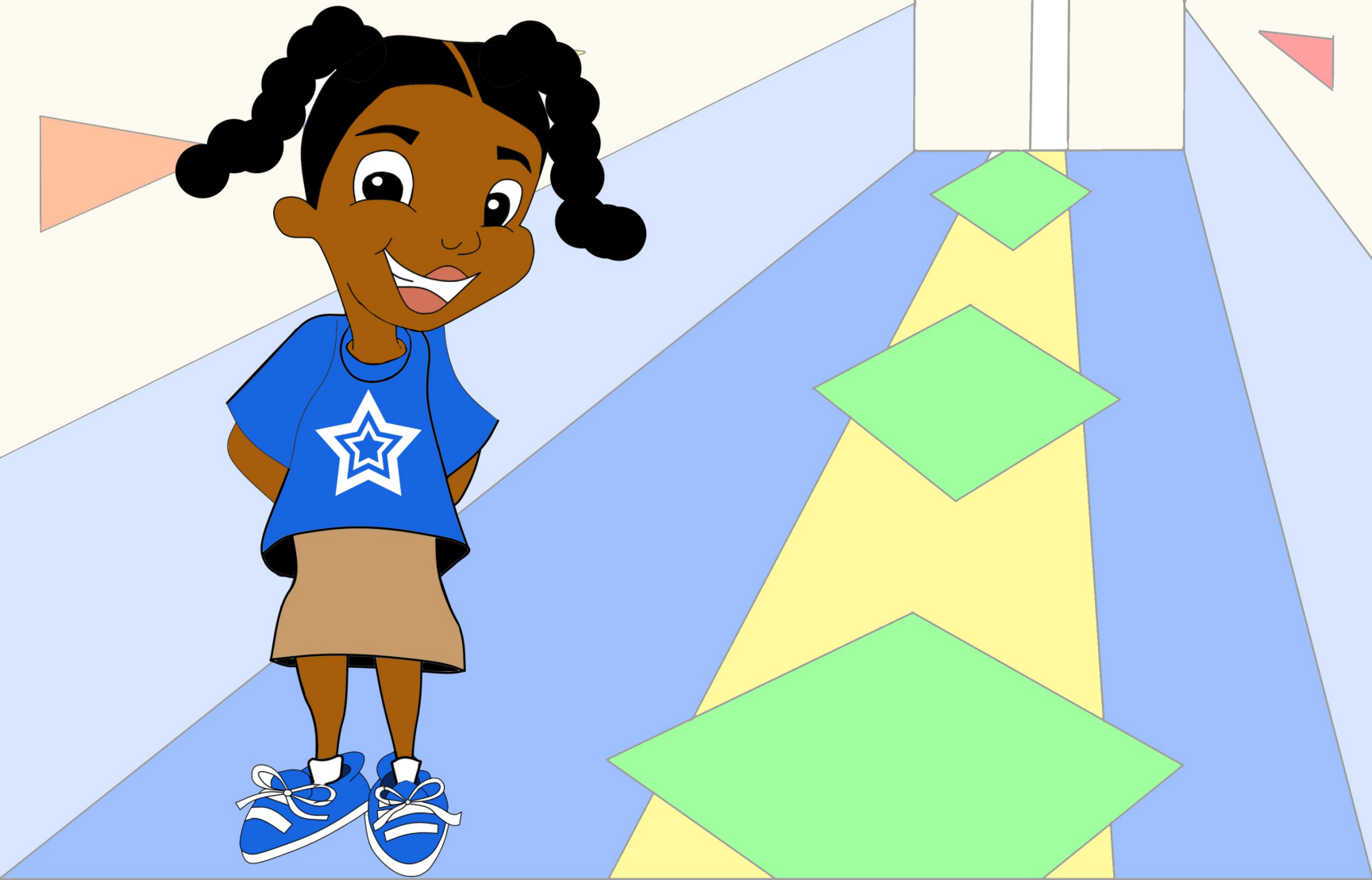

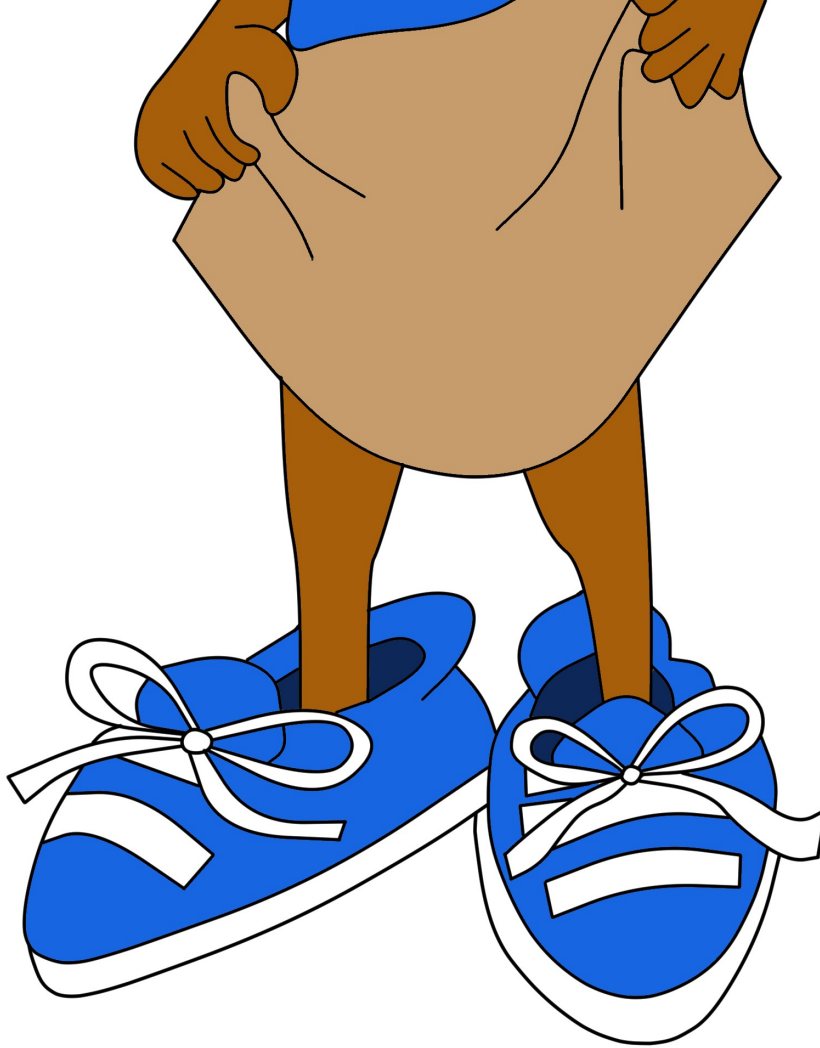
At school, I need to make sure I'm prepared.

at the beginning of the day.



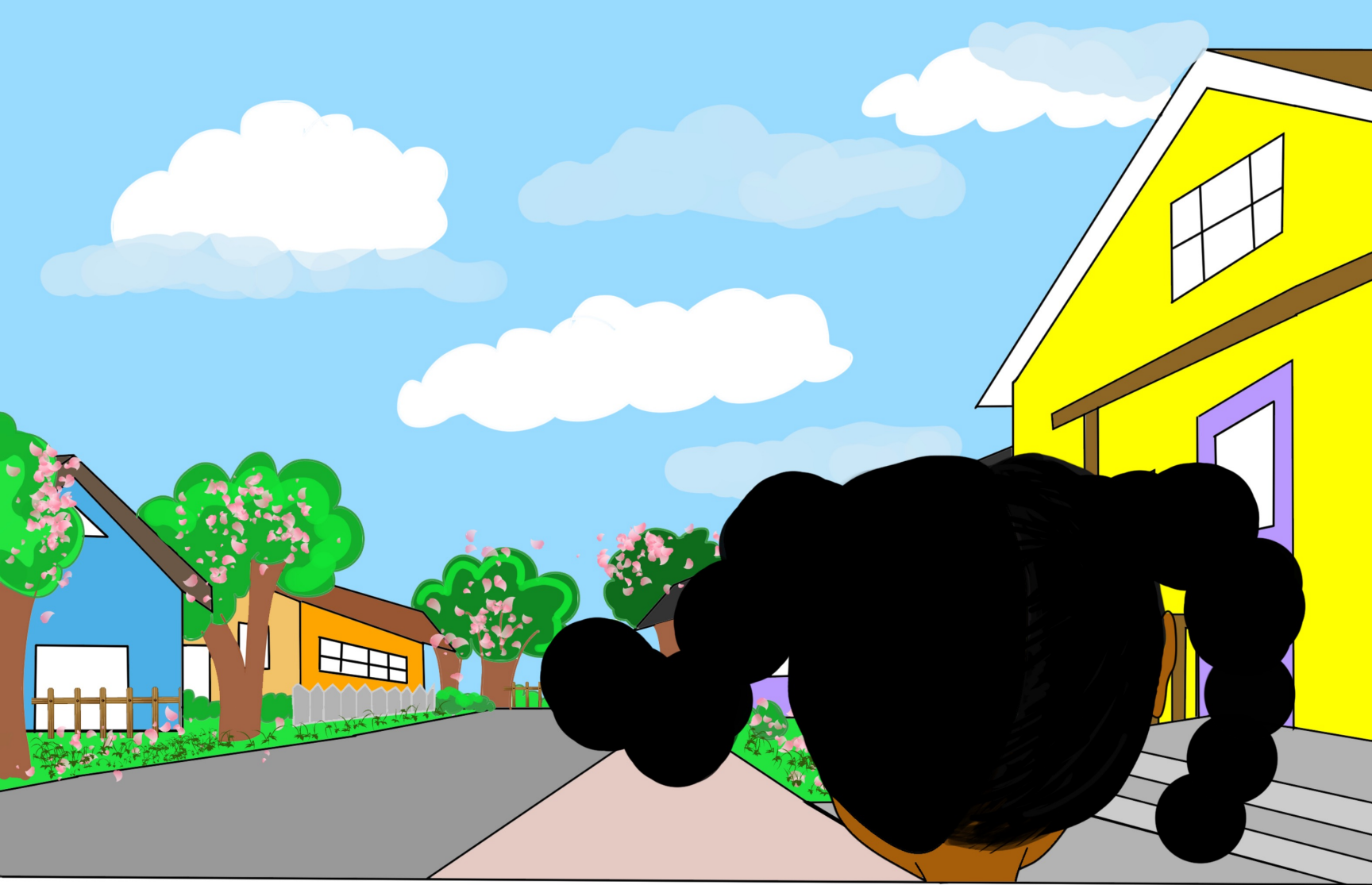
